I can feel my skin crawling

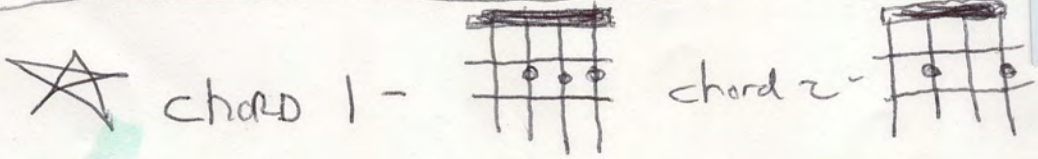
The size of the stones
